About the Speaker



Our guest speaker for the occasion is **Dr. Miriam Isaac**, **FRCPsych**, **Senior Consultant Psychiatrist**, **Leeds and York Partnership NHS FT.** Dr. Miriam Isaac is a senior consultant psychiatrist specializing in Intellectual Disabilities, Deaf Mental Health, and Autism. She graduated from Kottayam Medical College in 2000 and trained at Maudsley Hospital, Royal Free Hospital, and St. George's in London. A psychiatrist since 2002 and a senior consultant since 2013, she currently works at a National Child and Family Centre for Deaf Children. She is trained in CBT for insomnia and holds a level 4 in British Sign Language. Dr. Isaac is the clinical lead for behavioral sleep disorders for Deaf children in Northern England and chairs the Deaf LD Steering Group. She leads a national quality improvement project for Autism assessment in Deaf girls, focusing on behavioral sleep and Autism.

An accomplished researcher and speaker, Dr. Isaac has published peer reviewed articles and is currently researching Autistic burnout. She collaborates with psychiatric associations and charities in India. In 2023, she published her first poetry collection, "A Time to Heal." She founded and is the CEO of the "Towards Your True North" project, offering Autism assessment and support services. Dr. Isaac was elected a Fellow of the Royal College of Psychiatrists in 2023 for her exceptional contributions to the field.
